Morning Arrival

- For the safety and supervision concerns of the students, we ask that no students arrive at school until 7:50am
- All students are to be in their line by 8:10am to avoid being late for school. Students arriving after 8:10am are to report to the school office with their parent for their late slip.
- To avoid disruption to the classes, we ask that parents do not go to their child's classroom. All forgotten items should be labeled and dropped off at the school office.

Absences/Late Arrivals

In the event that your child or children will not be attending school or arriving late on a given day, we ask that you please call the school office and report the student/s out or arriving late for the day. We have implemented this procedure for the safety and protection of your children, and would appreciate your cooperation. Please call the school office by 9am @ 610-828-3082. An absence note should be written to the teacher stating the date and reason for the absence. This note should be returned to your child's teacher following the absence.
